What is the purpose of life?

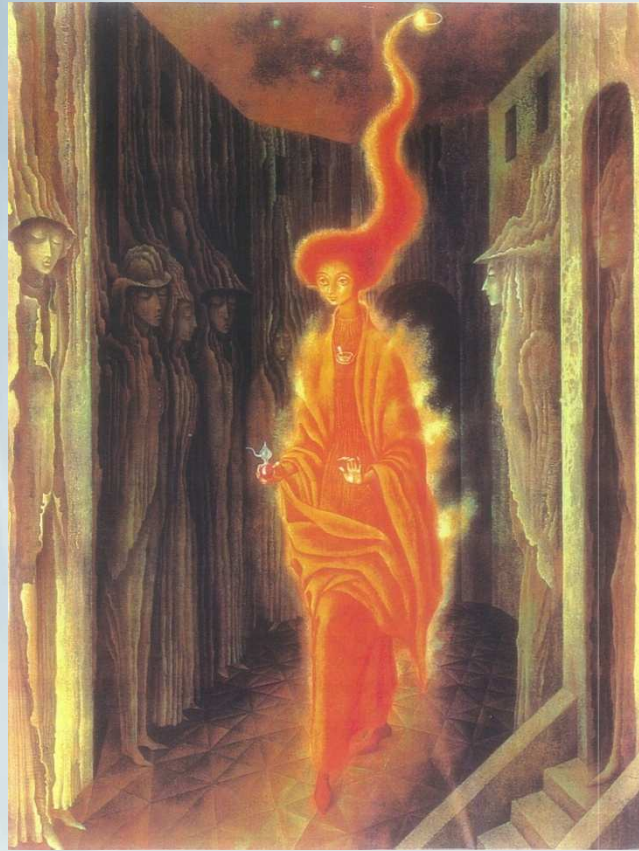
